- Straw bales will be provided for each age class by the Fair
- ONE throw per contestant
- Crossing the foul line will result in disqualification; \*age range dependant\*
- Furthest distance wins; Measurement will be closest point of bale to the start line.
- The Judge's/Fair Official decision will be final for all. If there is a tie, a tie breaker throw will be held
- All contestants must be present by the time of the toss with signed permission slip in hand. The required signature of parent or guardian (under 18 yrs of age) releases the Halton Agricultural Society from any financial responsibility due to accident.
- Registration for the Farmer Bale Toss will be one hour before throw time.
- Participation limited, first come, first served.
