- ENTRY TAGS: You may pick up your entry tags at the office ahead of time. If not, they will be available Wed. Sept 25th until 8:30pm or Thurs Sept 26th until 10am.
- **EXHIBITS:** Bring your exhibits (with attached entry tag) to under the Grandstand on Wed. Sept 25th from 3:00 pm - 9:00 pm or Thurs. Sept 26th from 9:00 am -10:30am.
- **JUDGING:** The halls will then be closed and judging will commence at 11:00 am.
- PICK UP: Exhibits MUST remain in the halls until closing Sunday, September 29th, 2024. Halls close at 4:30 pm. Pick-up will begin at 5:00 pm and close at 6:00 pm.

The Halton Agricultural Society is not responsible for exhibits not picked up by 6:00 pm. Halls close promptly at 6:00 pm. You must present your hall pass in order to pick up your entry.

ALL PHOTOS MUST BE mounted on black Bristol board with 1" border (CONSTRUCTION PAPER, MATTING AND WHITE BORDER AROUND PHOTOS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED). Exhibitor's entry tag to be securely stapled AT TOP RIGHT SIDE EDGE of border. No elastic bands or yarn. Suggestion: rubber cement should be used for secure mounting. DO NOT USE CONTACT CEMENT ON PHOTOS AS IT WILL DAMAGE PHOTOS. NO PHOTO MOUNTING CORNERS.

- 2. Photos to be current. All entries in this class must not have been exhibited at a previous Milton Fair.
- 3. Exhibitors in this class must be amateurs. No professional photography allowed.
- 4. Choice of colour or black and white, unless stated.
- 5. Picture Size 4" x 6" or 5" x 7", unless stated.
- 6. One submission per section.
- 7. Digital allowed in all classes.
- 8. No Polaroid photos.
- 9. No computer enhancement allowed.
- 10. One print per exhibitor, per section, unless stated otherwise.
