Rules and Regulations

- The participant must be able to pedal the tractor without assistance
- Pedal tractors will be furnished for all participants
- Participants must wear shoes
- The pulling tractor must stay between the lines of pulling lane at all times
- If the tractor leaves the pulling lane, the distance will be measured from the starting line to the point where the tractor crossed the boundary
- In case of a tie, there will be a pull-off to determine the winner
- Participants are eligible to enter classes 1 through 4 with an **age limit of 12 yrs. old**. The pedal tractor specifications do not allow for operation over 60 pounds. The pedal trike will accommodate participants over 60 pounds. Upon entry, the committee will determine which vehicle the participant will use in the competition.
- The Judge's decision will be final for all pulls.
- All contestants must be present by the time of pedal pull with a signed permission slip in hand. The required signature of a parent or guardian releases the Halton Agricultural Society from any financial responsibility due to accident.
- Registration for the tractor pull will be one hour before pull time.
- Participation limited, first come, first served.

There will be four (4) classes of contestants, they are:

CLASS - 1 • 5 yrs. old and under

CLASS - 2 • 6 & 7 yrs. old

CLASS - 3 • 8 & 9 yrs. old

CLASS - 4 • 10 – 12 yrs. old
